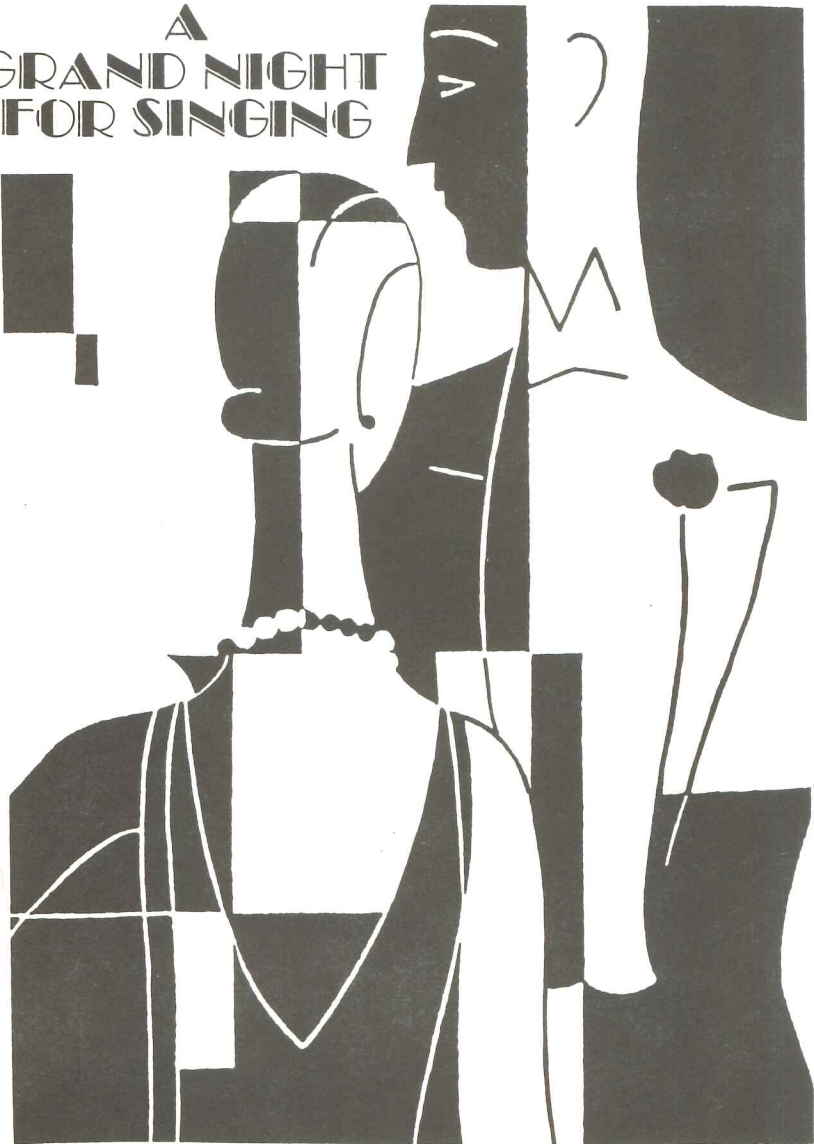

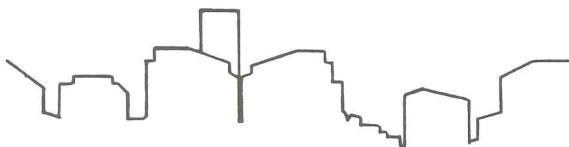

The River City Mixed Chorus is a member of GALA Choruses, an alliance of 59 men's, women's and mixed choruses in the United States and Canada. GALA Choruses produces a choral festival every three years, with the next in Seattle in 1989. GALA Choruses also plans annual conferences for directors and managers, addresses problems of mutual concern, and assists with the sharing of musical holdings.


A SPECIAL NOTE
